WATER/SEWAGE USERS AGREEMENT

The undersigned (hereinafter called the "member") does hereby make application to the Glendale Utility District Commission (hereinafter called "Commission") for water service and sewage service, if available. In consideration of the Commission's undertaking the financing and construction of a waterworks system and providing water service to residents of the Glendale/North Forrest area served by the Commission and sewage service to certain parts of this area, the member hereby agrees to the following:

I _____, hereby make application to Glendale Utility District for services, Water/Sewer on the _____ day of _____ 20____.

Witnesseth

1. To install and maintain at my (our) expense the necessary service line to the property occupied by me (us) to be connected with the waterworks system at the property line where the water line (and sewage, if available) runs on or adjacent to the public right-of-way;
 2. To arrange for the installation of the service lines referred to above by licensed plumber (s) and have these lines maintained by licensed plumbers(s) from the water works system line at the public right of way to the property occupied by me (us);
 3. To begin using service immediately after being notified by the Commission that service is available, or to pay not less than the minimum service bill for a minimum of one (1) month after notification by the Commission that service is available, whether or not a connection is made or water consumed. It is further understood that any consumption in excess of the minimum rate will be charged for in accordance with the schedule of monthly rates published by the Commission;
 4. To use the service in accordance with rules and regulation established by the Commission and to promptly pay for the service at the applicable schedule of rates. It is further understood that should it be necessary to shut off the member's service for failure to pay for services, a fee established by the Commission in its rate schedule will be charged for reconnection of service;
 5. If my (our) residence or business is not connected to the waste water (sewage) system operated by the Glendale Utility District Commission, (we) will furnish to the Commission a certificate from the State Health Department that my (our) wastewater (sewage) system complies with the applicable laws and regulations of the State Health Department. The Commission will accept the "Notice of Intent" issued by the Health Department pending receipt of the final certificate of approval;
 6. To grant, and I (we) do hereby grant authority to the Commission, its successors and assigns, to enter upon the premises owned, rented, or claimed or leased by the member for the purpose of inspecting and maintaining the system contemplated and designed to serve the member; and it is further understood that if for any reason the Commission is unable to provide the service anticipated by the Application and Water/Sewage Users Agreement, the full amount of my (our) deposits shall be refunded.
 7. To install and maintain at my expense all necessary service lines, plumbing and fixtures to enable the property owned by me to be connected to the Utility's water meter.
 8. I understand that if I do not receive a statement of current monthly charges it is my responsibility to contact the Utility during normal business hours to arrange payment and the fact that I have not received a water statement does not waive my responsibility to pay those charges or any late assessments or service charges that result for my failure to remit the proper payment when it is due.
 9. To use the water in accordance with the rules and regulations established in the Utility's Bylaws and Amendments, which includes prohibiting me from connection or allowing the connection of other residential dwellings or businesses to my water service.
 10. To properly notify the Utility when I change mailing addresses and/or phone number, if I relinquish control of my property or for any other reason to request that water service to my property be terminated.
 11. If the water bill is not paid, the Utility will use the deposit to pay the bill. When water service is terminated, the deposit less the outstanding bill will be refunded.
 12. Transferring or disconnecting water/sewer service should be done in person with proper identification.
- * (93) We ask that all customers have a cut off valve installed within one foot of the meter. Also, it is the responsibility of the property owner to repair water/sewer leaks on the residential side of the meter.
14. To pay the following schedule of fees and charges in accordance with the rules and regulations established by the Commission, said charges include an administrative fee, which shall be non-refundable, and a meter deposit which shall be refundable:
